Senior Schedule: Each WHCS senior schedule is tailored to meet the needs of the individual student. Many students participate in our dual credit program, traditional classroom assignment or career certificate programs. Start and end time for the students vary depending on the program in which students have been assigned. Students participate in programs from Central New Mexico Nursing Program, Institute of American Indian Arts, Central New Mexico, Pueblo of Jemez Tribal Programs and Jemez Health and Human Services.

Gear UP NM/WHCS Tutoring: If your student descends below a 70% in a class, they are required to attend our tutoring program on Friday's from 2:00-4:00 p.m. In addition, Saturday school may be assigned to students who do not complete assignments. The tutoring program is mandatory. Students will be referred Instructor.

Reading/Academic Vocabulary: All students are required to participate in our reading/academic vocabulary program. Students will be placed on an individual growth plan which will provide the opportunity to increase their reading levels. Only students that have achieved 12th grade reading level are allowed to be withdrawn from the course. Students must complete certain levels weekly depending on their individual growth plan based on their Reading Plus/Lexia assessment results. Students will be required to stay on Friday's to complete their weekly reading levels.

Presentations: WHCS is a community school model. Trained professionals from college partners, outside agencies (UNM Law School-Marshall Brennan Projects, Watershed etc.) Pueblo of Jemez Tribal Programs and Jemez Health and Human Services will provide educational presentations to students/staff and community members throughout the school year.

Gear UP NM Support Services: Meetings will be conducted bi-weekly to address student progress in reading, college preparation requirements, community based instruction activities and supplemental student support services to ensure opportunities of success is provided.
