

McKinney-Vento Transportation Agreement

The purpose of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act is to assist families that are experiencing homelessness or a temporary transition. Walatowa High Charter School will strive to remove barriers that would prevent your child from receiving a quality education. We will provide transportation for your child under the McKinney-Vento Act. To receive transportation services under the provisions of the McKinney-Vento Act, your child (which includes you as your child's parent/guardian) must abide by the rules listed in this agreement. We may suspend your child's transportation services if your child does not comply with these rules.

Walatowa High School Students:

- Student must be ready and waiting at the agreed upon AM pick-up location and must board the transportation immediately following the PM bell.
- If your child will be absent from school for any reason, you must notify the WHCS by 7:00 AM by telephone at 505-527-3392 and email a fgarcia@walatowahcs.org.
- You may not have door to door service and the pick-up location may be outside.
- The transportation will wait for only 5 minutes. Being on time is critical for all students.
- The transportation may not arrive or return every day at the same time so please be patient.
- There may be a need to coordinate transportation with another district as a shared responsibility.
- Students (grade 9 -12) will be dropped off whether an adult is present to meet them so please plan for your Student's arrival from school.
- If your child/Student does not use the ride without letting transportation know, it is referred to as a "No load." After 3-5 "No loads" the district will suspend the transportation. And, you will have to meet with the liaison at the school to reinstate the ride.
- Students must comply with all district transportation guidelines. The district reserves the right to suspend transportation for failure to follow transportation behavior guidelines.
- If the district suspends transportation for failure to follow the guidelines set forth in this agreement, it will be your responsibility to be sure that your child/Student get to school.
- It is important for you to communicate with our office if there is a change of address or a new pickup/drop-off location. Please notify us immediately to prevent interruption of your child's transportation.
